

HOW TO PARK

Stay in the lines. Respect reserved zones.



✓ DO THIS

PARK CENTERED, STRAIGHT, BETWEEN THE YELLOW LINES

Pull straight in. Equal space on both sides. If you're crooked, back up and try again.

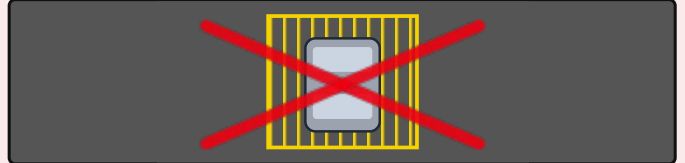
✗ DON'T CROOKED ACROSS A LINE



Crossing a line or angled across two spots = repark.



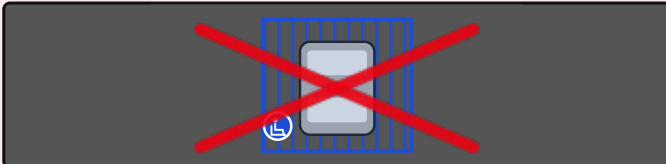
✗ DON'T YELLOW STRIPED ZONE



Yellow stripes = no parking. Fire lane & building clearance.



✗ DON'T BLUE STRIPED ZONE



Blue stripes = wheelchair access aisle. Never block it.



✗ DON'T HANDICAP SPOT WITHOUT PERMIT



Requires placard on mirror or disability plate.



PARK RIGHT · BE CONSIDERATE · AVOID THE TICKET

Ten extra seconds to repark beats a fine, a tow, or a blocked wheelchair user.

WHY YOU GOT THIS FLIER

Someone saw **your vehicle parked incorrectly** — over a line, in a striped no-parking zone, or in a handicap space without a valid permit — and left this on your windshield.

This is **not an advertisement**, not a sales pitch, not a flyer for any product, business, religion, or political cause. No one is collecting your information. There is nothing to buy, sign up for, or respond to.

It is a reminder, plain and simple. Bad parking blocks fire lanes, traps shopping carts, prevents wheelchair users from reaching their vehicles, forces other drivers to squeeze in or skip the spot, and can earn you a fine or a tow.

Please take a moment to look at the diagrams above. Next time you park, pull straight in, stay between the lines, and respect the painted zones. That's the entire ask.
